Such an education is vital to students’ success as individuals and as members of society, emphasising not only creativity and innovation, but also the values of broad cultural understanding and social harmony that the arts can engender.”

Cultural Infusion has created various ways for arts, music & dance to be part of every school curriculum and part of every student’s education. Our programs support the Key Learning Areas and numerous objectives of the Curriculum Standards Framework in states and territories nationwide.

Research is clear, active cultural participation can help children reach their potential from an early age. Over and above the obvious development of individual creativity and self-expression, school based arts participation can increase learners’ confidence and motivation, thereby improving school attendance rates, academic outcomes and the wellbeing and life skills of children and young people.

Essential learning skills proven to be increased by arts and music include:

- reasoning and problem solving
- mathematics and language
- lateral thinking and memory
- time management and eloquence
- social and team skills

Specific areas where Cultural Infusion can help:

Languages other than English – LOTE

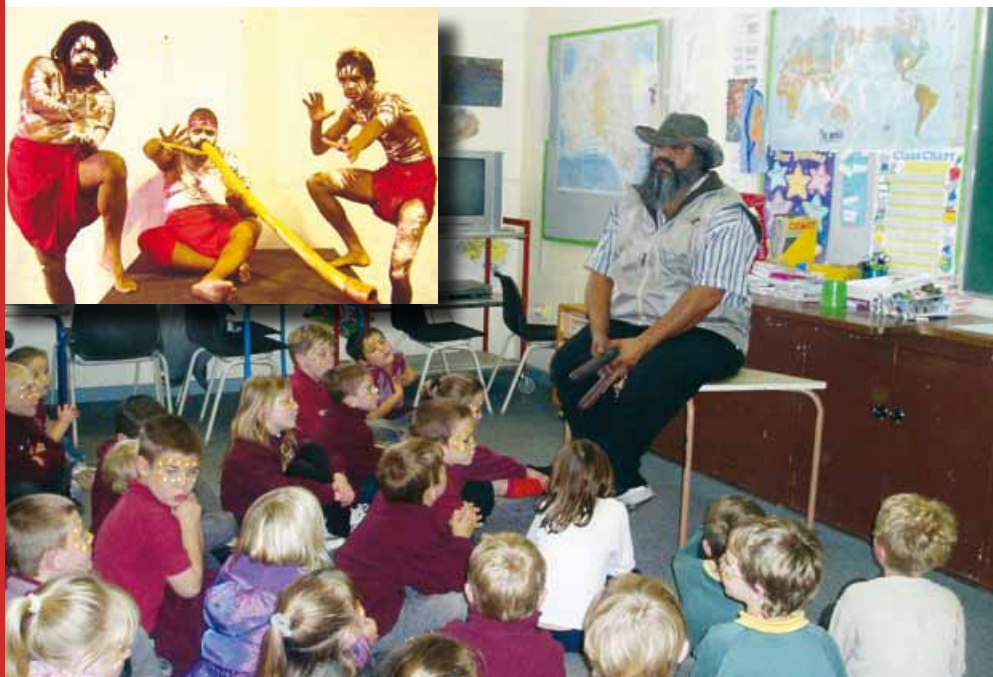
This appropriate education tool provides a series of empowering hands on workshops, for students of all ages.

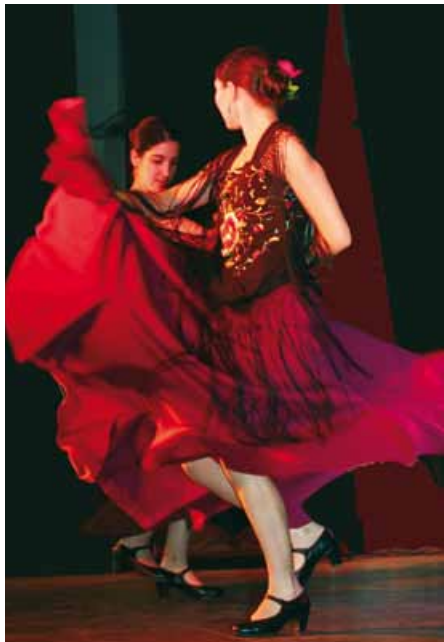

Represent – Artist Residencies and Workshops

The 'Represent' program focuses on building face to face relationships between artists and young people, moving away from single sessions of 50 minute sessions, to a long-term Artist in Residence model. The semester long program aims to promote self-confidence and deal with specific issues related to socio-economic disadvantage, cultural diversity and at-risk behaviour amongst young people by engaging them through the arts.

Represent programs incorporate a range of activities presented and facilitated by professional arts and cultural practitioners, local elders and experienced educators. Teaching methods are lively, interactive and fun with a focus on teamwork, to produce ideas and results which can be used to support coursework.

A 'Represent' artist-in-residency will enhance your existing school curriculum for: Music, Dance, Theatre, Movement, Event Management, Graphic Design, Visual Arts, Multimedia, English, ESL and VCAL, or can be developed with a performance outcome in mind to showcase your school's productions, presentations or community events.

Participation in workshop programs has been proven to increase essential learning skills and instil self confidence in students.

The Represent program aims to engage young people from diverse backgrounds through the arts in order to:

- provide an environment within the school where young people can gain self-confidence, connect with their peers and become motivated to participate positively in school life,
- encourage their participation in community life,
- promote healthy and active lifestyles,
- focus on teamwork, to produce ideas and results which can be used to support coursework, and
- encourage students to think laterally by working through a creative process.

We offer term/semester-long residencies or can tailor one specifically to your needs and interests. Artists available for our Represent residencies include specialists in Hip-Hop dance, Rap, Street Art, African drumming and dance, Bollywood dance, theatre, circus skills, and traditional dance.

PRICE RANGE: 50 minute workshops start from \$440.00 plus GST plus materials with a maximum attendance of 50 students. Residencies start from \$3,500 plus GST per term.

Rates for Represent Residencies & Workshops will vary, as each program is customised to fit a school's specific requirements.

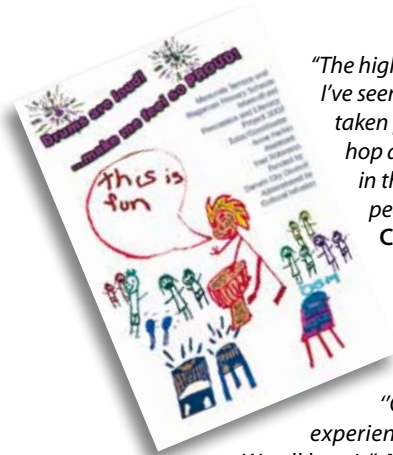

Teacher Resource Notes

For your assistance free Teacher Resource Notes (TRNs) are available upon request for most of our programs. Designed in collaboration with our artists and presenters, TRNs support teachers when developing lessons around our program material.

Duration

All general incursion programs are designed to run for 50 minutes. Multicultural All Day Programs are broken up into 25 minute sessions and our Aboriginal for a Day program runs from approximately 9:00 am till 3:00 pm depending on school bell times. Performers will arrive approximately 30 minutes prior to the incursion start time. Our artists are all completely flexible and will work within your requirements.

Terms and Conditions

Performance Requirements

Technical requirements generally include a cleared 4 x 4 metre performance space with access to power. We will advise you accordingly of other specific requirements prior to the incursion. These may include things like a CD player and microphone.

Regional Touring

Regional tours rely heavily on interest levels and overall student numbers from surrounding schools for viability. Get together with schools in your region to negotiate a special tour.

Regional tours may incur a small surcharge per student to cover additional expenses associated with touring where airfares, ground transportation and accommodation are required. We will endeavour to work within your budget and time frames. Please call us on 1800 010 069 for further information.

Confirmation

When your program details have been finalised, a letter of agreement outlining booking details will be emailed or faxed to you. The booking and artists are confirmed only when the signed Letter of Agreement is returned to Cultural Infusion.

Payment

Please note that the agreed fee on a signed Letter of Agreement is final and any relevant changes are subject to the cancellation fees detailed below. All fees are GST inclusive. Cheques are payable to Cultural Infusion Ltd within seven days of the performance.

Cancellations – Metropolitan Areas

A 100% cancellation fee will apply if a booking is cancelled 14 days or less from the performance date. A 50% cancellation fee will apply if a booking is cancelled 15-28 days prior to the performance date.

Cancellations – Rural Areas

Due to expenses associated with regional tours, an immediate 50% cancellation fee will apply if a school with a signed agreement cancels. A 100% cancellation fee will be charged if notification is not received within 60 days.

Changes to the program may occur, including costs, individual performers and groups. Whilst every effort is made to ensure the availability of your chosen performer or group prior to booking confirmation, we cannot make any assurances in this regard. Regional tours are subject to student numbers and a relative volume of bookings in the area and are processed on an individual basis. Cost per student is subject to change and you will be notified if this occurs.
