These days' children as young as 7 years old are encouraged to post their profiles on the internet with services such as instant messenger, blogs and social networking sites such as Facebook and MySpace. With a medium so closely linked with personal identity no wonder it has become a hot spot for bullying behaviour. Cyber bullying can be even more painful than face-to-face bullying and a great number of children don't even know they are doing it.

Cyber Sense encourages the awareness of safe behaviour when using the internet and mobile phones. Young people gain valuable insight into the forms of cyber bullying & how to avoid the traps of the cyber world! Through interactive performance, workshops and activities, this program will:

- Teach students how to identify cyber bullying behaviour
- Reveal the different types of cyber bullying behaviour
- Educate students how to take care of their friend's and their own privacy on-line
- Promote care and responsible use of technology
