EDUCATIONAL THEATRE PROGRAM ON CYBER SAFETY



Venture into the virtual screen with this dynamic brother and sister duo. One afternoon after school Felix and Alex are fighting over the use of their family computer. They are so immersed with the internet that their 'real life' and their 'cyber life' begin to literally combine! When Felix goes missing in the 'Cyber Wonder World' his sister is the only one who can bring him back. Along the way Alex learns about the importance of internet privacy, cyber stalking and safe browsing.

These days' children as young as 7 years old are encouraged to post their profiles on the internet with services such as instant messenger, blogs and social networking sites such as Facebook and MySpace. With a medium so closely linked with personal identity no wonder it has become a hot spot for bullying behaviour. A national study by Netsafe in 2007 revealed that cyber bullying can be even more painful than face-to-face bullying and a great number of children don't even know they are doing it.

Cyber Sense encourages the awareness of safe behaviour when using the internet and mobile phones. Young people gain valuable insight into the forms of cyber bullying & how to avoid the traps of the cyber world! Through interactive performance, workshops and activities, this program will:

- Teach students how to identify unsafe cyber practices
- Reveal the different types of cyber bullying behaviour
- Educate students how to take care of their friend's and their own privacy on-line
- Promote care and responsible use of technology
